

The Fifth Arundel Go Tournament

Saturday 1st June 2013

Arundel Go Tournament will be held on Saturday 1st June 2013 at **Arundel Football Club**, Mill Road, Arundel, West Sussex BN18 9PA. (Mobile phone contact on the day: 07549 898376)

This will be a three round McMahon Tournament under AGA rules. The time limits will be 1 hour per player sudden death. Komi will be 7. Prizes will be awarded to those winning 2.5 or 3 games. The overall winner will keep the Arundel trophy for a year.

The charge covers tea and coffee but not lunch. Arundel has several pubs, tea-shops and restaurants all within easy walking distance.

How to get there:

By Car Travelling on the A27/Arundel Road over the railway bridge into Arundel, take the 2nd exit at the roundabout onto The Causeway. Continue over a small bridge over the river and immediately turn right at the mini roundabout onto Mill Road. The entrance to a pay-and-display car park is 100 yards further on the right and the football club entrance is in the left hand corner of the main car park. There is limited parking in the small club car park, but a large pay-and-display car park is situated right outside the ground. Alternatively there is free parking on Mill Road.

If coming from the north go down the High Street and turn left at the mini roundabout (next to the mock Tudor post office) into Mill Road.

By Train

Arundel train station is a 12 minute walk from the Football Club. The **09:02 from London Victoria** should get you to the tournament in time and booking in advance is advisable for a cheaper ticket from <http://www.southernrailway.com>
