

Shropshire Go Tournament

Hinstock, North Shropshire, Saturday 21st September 2013

Basics

The Shropshire Go Tournament will be held on Saturday 21st September 2013 at Hinstock Village Hall, TF9 2TE. It will be a three round McMahon tournament with a formal game review teaching session at tiered levels between rounds 2 and 3.

Tournament details

The tournament will be 3 rounds, run using the McMahon system, with time limits of 50 mins, and then overtime (20/5, then 40/5, finally 60/5). Komi will be 7. Prizes will be awarded to those winning 2.5 or 3 games, and a mystery prize.

Approximate Timetable:

- Round 2: 13:20
- Game reviews 15:30-16:30
- Round 3: 16:30
- Prize giving: around 18:30

The game review session will be three parallel sessions, tiered approximately as follows:

- Dan player reviews low kyu
- Low kyu player reviews high SDK
- SDK reviews DDK

Following the tournament, there will be a meal in a local restaurant.

Refreshments

Free tea/coffee throughout. Lunch offered on the premises will be homemade at reasonable cost. Within a stone's throw is the local pub, village shop, sports ground and fishing pool.
