**Accommodation.** The Commodore has a few rooms for B&B. Contact the Inn direct. There are many hotels and B&B s in Grange and the surrounding area.

A new B&B recently opened is at Stumble Hill, Kents Bank, (about 2 miles from the playing site) with 1 or possibly 2 bedrooms. All details can be found from the Grange tourist website.

**Directions.** Grange is 20 minutes from junction 36 on the M6 – follow the signs for Barrow then Grange.

There is also a mainline station about 5 minutes walk from the Commodore Inn.

The Commodore Inn is just off to the left of Main Street before going up the steep hill to the clock tower.

Parking is a problem. There is room for only 1 or 2 cars at the Inn. There is a public car park next to the Inn but it is expensive for all day parking. Street parking is limited to 1 hour. Best is to park at your accommodation or drive out west of town to find derestricted street parking (about 15 minutes walk back).
