



The 13 x 13 go set in the photograph was constructed in response to interest in go expressed by a blind American friend of mine. It was made from 1/4" square wooden rod and two sizes of dowel, 7/8" and 1/8" in diameter. The only tools required were a hacksaw and a 1/8" power drill, however access to a band saw facilitated slicing up the 7/8" dowel into stones. All the stones are drilled through the centre; the white stones have flat surfaces, the black stones are slightly thicker and have studs of 1/8" dowel pressed into them. Similarly, studs are glued into the intersections of the board; the stones push onto them reasonably tightly.

A modification made since the photograph was taken has been to label the 4-4 points by inlaying the surrounding recesses with triangular blocks.
