Jim Barty, (4-dan, from Hammersmith Go Club, won the Challengers'
Tournament with a record of 7/8. The tournament, run on the Swiss System, was held at IVC, Covent Garden, London, from 29th May - 1st June. 22 of those qualified to compete entered. Other good results were Adam Pirani, Jim Bates, Terry Stacey, and Richard Granville, all with 6/8.

The newly instituted NOT The Challengers' Tournament held concurrently on the first three days attracted about 20 entries. Mark Cumper won the Geoffrey Cray Go-ban for the best Kyu player; his record was 5/6. Honourable mention also to Jim Hazelden with 4/4: he nobly alternated between the two events to keep parities correct as players came and went.

The only disappointment was the low entry from weaker players. Thanks to Andrew Grant for quietly efficient organisation.

This will be the first time in four years that Terry Stacey has failed to win the right to challenge Matthew Macfadyen for the British Championship, but Terry has continued his string of good results elsewhere. He won the Bracknell Tournament on 15th May outright, and at Amsterdam (22nd-23rd May) he and Matthew shared in a five-way tie for second place, with 4/6. First in that tournament was Yo (Korea) with 6/6.

S.E. Hughes, I. Marsh, A.H. Summerville, I. Rocke, S. Winter, S. Talary, and M. Trent all returned 3/3 results at Bracknell. Attendance was a record at 74.
