The Tournament

The winner becomes the British 13x13 Go Champion and holds the splendid trophy until the next championship. The current champion is Andrew Simons and past winners include Matthew Cocke, Des Cann and the late Terry Stacey. We will use the same tournament system which has been very successful in previous years – those in contention for the top prize play even games, others play handicap games.

The handicap system has worked very well in the past. Usually around half the handicap games played by players of different strength are won by the weaker player and half by the stronger. So we hope that as usual this will be an attractive event for novices and young players as well as those aiming to be a national champion.

The entry fee is £7.50 (non-BGA members add £1.50) and concessions are £4 (non-BGA members add £1).
