**Prizes** will be awarded to those on 4.5 wins or above (extra prizes at organisers' discretion).

£20: Standard

£10: This discretionary, reduced concession price applies as follows:

UK residents who are: under 18 on 31st August 2024,

or under 26 and studying full-time at an approved educational establishment in the UK, or receiving an unemployment or Pension Credit benefit.

Additional payment(s) are required for:

- + £10 where entrants are not members of the BGA or their own country's Go association
- + £3 late entry fee for entries received after Tuesday 25th June

All the above are halved for people playing on only one of the days.
