TOURNAMENT RESULTS

BRITISH CHAMPIONSHIP

The challenger, Piers Shepperson, leads by 2-1 in the best of 5 match, Terry Stacey having won the second game by a street and Piers the third by 1 1/2 points.

British Schools Championship

This was won for the fourth year running by Furze Platt School, equalling the record of Leeds School, who won for the first four years. Two other schools were competing this year: Stowe School and the Gyosel International School of Milton Keynes.
